How I wonder what you are!



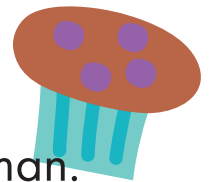
## I'M A LITTLE TEAPOT

Life is but a dream.



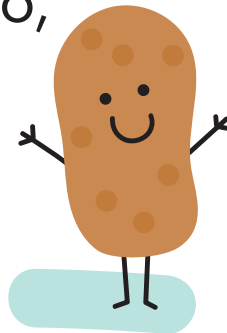

Seven potato, more.



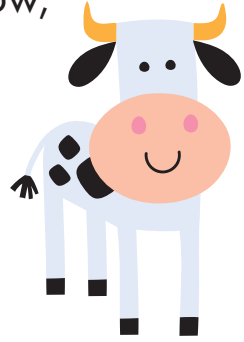
## THE ITSY BITSY SPIDER

spout again.



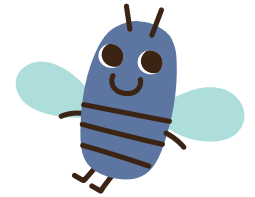
## OLD MACDONALD
