





Create a routine of reading. Focus on the bonding experience of holding the child and exploring books and stories. From these daily reading experiences, your child will learn basic sounds and concepts that serve as building blocks for literacy and cognitive development.

Try these 5 approaches with the recommended books:

- Read with expression and use different voices for different characters.
- 2. Point to pictures to build vocabulary. Look for similar objects or pictures throughout the day.
- 3. Play with sounds and find at least one word, sound or sound effect on each page to repeat multiple times. Encourage the child to repeat the sounds or words while you read.
- **4. Keep books within reach** in baskets or on low shelves so the child can independently choose their own book and explore it.
